## To Re-open In Person Camp or Go Virtual?...This is Just ONE of the Questions to Consider

## COCA-I Townhall Feb. 10, 2021

- Can you open in person Camp? Can you do it? This is a loaded question that snowballs so many other questions...
- What authorizations do we require?
  - o Local/State regulations-what are they?
  - Staff/Board/Medical Committee or Medical Staff- do they support this?
- What permissions do we require?
  - o Donors- will they support in person or virtual?
  - Families/Patients
  - o Volunteers- are they available for in person camp?
- Will your rental site be open?
- What are the policies and procedures of your rental site and can you follow them?
- What is your timeline for decision making?
- Can you afford it? Equitable? From extra supplies needed to helping families get to camp? No bus, then do you consider gas cards for families?
- Can you afford TO NOT host Camp?
- Camper eligibility-who will be allowed to attend? Staff eligibility- can you 'get by' w/limited #
   of people/staff
- Do you test campers/staff? Can you afford tests at ~\$50-75pp? Do you require campers/staff to arrive with a negative test? Who pays for pre-camp tests? Do you test again mid week? Can you afford a second test?
- Can we reasonably meet the requirements set by the ACA Field Guide?
- What NPI's will you use?
- What capacity will you operate at? 50%? 75%? 100%?
- Do we take kids on active treatment? Do certain underlying conditions make a camper/staff member ineligible? If so, what are they?
- Do we require vaccinations for staff/medical staff?
- Are we comfortable with a child/staff member potentially contracting COVID-19? What do we
  do if someone tests positive? What is the plan? What do we do if someone tests positive
  AFTER camp? What is the plan?
- What PPE do we need? Can we afford the extra PPE? How and when do we purchase it? Can we get enough supplies in time?
- Do we change the format of camp? Offer Family Camp? How much are we willing to change about our program before it no longer reflects our culture/values?
